



SERVICE SCHOLARSHIPS

MINUTEMAN SCHOLARSHIP

The Minuteman is a Guaranteed Reserve Forces Duty (GRFD) scholarship that provides full in-state tuition and fees, or up to \$10,000 room and board between 2-4 years for eligible candidates. Scholarship recipients also receive a monthly stipend of \$420, and a yearly book allowance of \$1,200. In addition, Minuteman recipients participate in the Simultaneous Membership Program, which gives them experience with an Army National Guard unit while earning additional money for their service. Applicants must be a US Citizen, have a minimum high school GPA of 2.5, and achieve a minimum score of 920 on the SAT or 19 on the ACT.

GEORGIA MILITARY SCHOLARSHIP AT UNIVERSITY OF NORTH GEORGIA (UNG)

Covers room & board, tuition, fees, uniforms, and books for up to 4 years at UNG. (Total \$85,000.)


SIMULTANEOUS MEMBERSHIP PROGRAM

Combine ROTC with Guard Service and receive Army National Guard pay on top of an ROTC allowance. Students can participate in both the Guard and their college's ROTC program.

- ★ Qualify for up to 100% tuition with Guaranteed Reserve Forces Duty (GRFD) scholarship
- ★ Receive monthly stipend of \$420 per month
- ★ Get more money every month through the Montgomery GI Bill and Kicker
- ★ Commission as a Second Lieutenant upon graduation

STATE SERVICE SCHOLARSHIP AT GEORGIA **MILITARY COLLEGE (GMC)**

Covers room & board, tuition, fees, uniforms, and books for up to 2 years at GMC. (Total \$40,000.)




